- Continue with the support of the Cluster Head Of Curriculum position at Burnett Heads State School for 2022 with the support of the Regional Director
- Embed, review and refine case management policy and approach across the Sugar Coast Cluster to ensure every student is succeeding

Our initiatives include

- Provision of targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum and pre and post moderation processes in both English and Maths
- Provision of on-going support from the Head of Curriculum (shared between cluster schools) and Middle Management (Curriculum Coach) to deepen teachers' understanding of the Australian Curriculum and pre and post moderation processes
- Provision of focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Provision of resources, including additional teacher and teacher-aide time, to implement small group support to achieve individual student goals and achieve year level standards or to support Individual Curriculum Plans
